A dreamer, Joseph imagined that he was a powerful leader and his brothers bowed down to him; when he told them about this, they grew angrier.

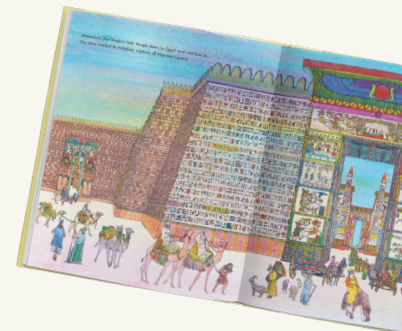

## THE PRIEST WHO STAYED IN GAZA

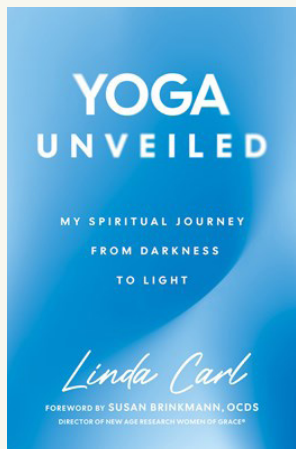

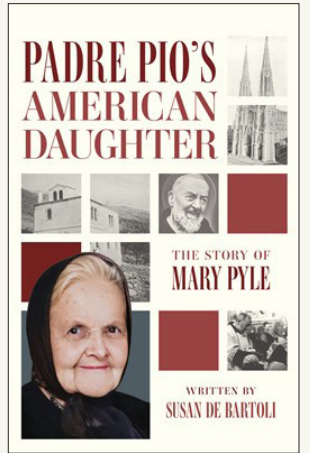
## PADRE PIO'S AMERICAN DAUGHTER
